Hull Performing Arts has been involved with more than theater from the very beginning.

- Partnered with Weir River Watershed Association and Surfrider Foundation on the Weir River Estuary Center.
- Participated in events supporting the Carousel including story reading and a Halloween fundraiser.
- Created *Harbor Haunts* with the Hull Lifesaving Museum to celebrate the stories and legends of the Boston Harbor Islands.
- Supported Hull schools in various ways including the purchase of a Hull High School Auditorium seat, reenacting a historic town meeting at the Old Town Hall in the village, and celebrating Arts Day with Jacobs School students.
- Promoted Fort Revere by staging outdoor productions.

For many summers since 1992, Hull Performing Arts has offered theater at Fort Revere. From Greek and Shakespeare workshops to full musical productions, the outdoor amphitheater offers a unique experience for the cast, crew and audience.
